CONFIDENTIALITY

Information you reveal in your therapy session will be kept strictly confidential. Information will not be given to anyone without your written permission.

Parents of children receiving therapy should know that children will also be protected from the unauthorized disclosure of information. In addition, in many situations, attempts will be made to keep the child's disclosure confidential from parents unless disclosure is clearly therapeutic and is around the safety of the child.

There are legal limits with regard to confidentiality. Certain situations are required by law to reveal information obtained during therapy sessions without written permission. These situations include, but are not limited to: where there is a clear and substantial risk of imminent or serious harm to self or others, where there is evidence of child abuse or abuse to vulnerable adults, and when there is a court order by law.
